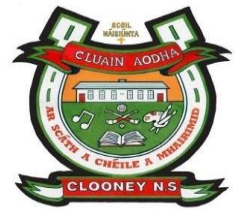

COVID – 19 Updates

I understand that as advice is updated from the Government it can be hard to keep up. If in doubt about whether your child can attend school, please contact us or the HSE for advice. If your child/children have any of the following symptoms they should **not** attend school until they are 48 hours symptom free.

- A temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or more
- A new cough – this can be any kind of cough, not just dry
- Loss or changed sense of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Aches and pains
- Sore throat
- Headaches
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Feeling sick or vomiting
- Diarrhoea
